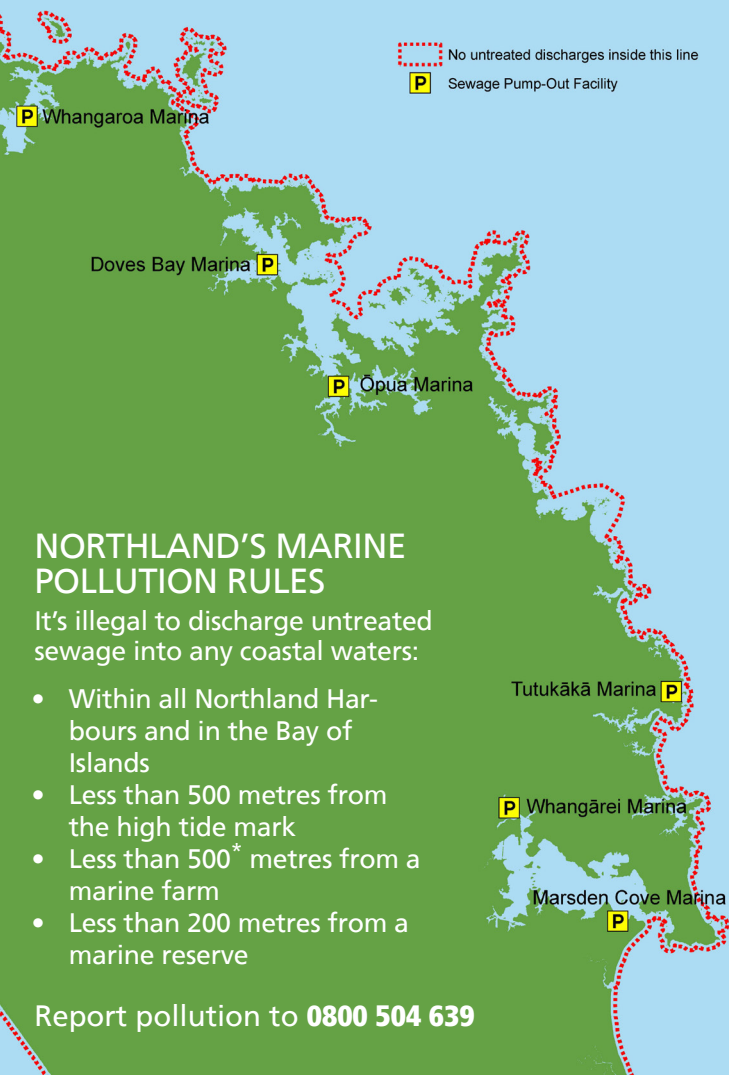



Keep our harbours clean

Dispose of boat sewage properly



Staying overnight on the boat?



HELP KEEP NORTHLAND'S HARBOURS CLEAN FOR PEOPLE TO SWIM AND COLLECT KAI MOANA – STICK TO THE RULES

When staying overnight on the boat you need:

- A sewage treatment system or a holding tank
- To be at least 500 m* away from any marine farm

For longer stays, you need to:

- Empty your holding tank, outside of the marine pollution limits
 - every 5 days in mooring zones
 - every 10 days outside mooring areas
- Leave the harbour at least every two weeks or if you are in the outer Bay of Islands or outer Whangaroa Harbour move at least one kilometre every 14 days
